4. Provost and Vice-Provosts

4.1 The appointment of the Provost and Vice-Provosts shall be made by the Council following consultation with a Committee appointed by the Senate of which the Vice-Chancellor and President shall be a member ex-officio and Chair (with the right to delegate such Chair role).

4.2 The Provost and Vice-Provosts may be removed from office by the Council after consideration of a report from a Committee constituted for the purpose by the Council comprising three members of the Council at least two of whom shall not be members of staff or students of the University. The Procedure to be used by the Committee shall be as set out in an Ordinance.

4.3 The Provost and Vice-Provosts may resign from office by writing addressed to the Council by a period of notice approved by Council from time to time and on his or her death, bankruptcy or mental or physical incapacity for a period of at least three months rendering him or her incapable of carrying out his or her responsibilities shall automatically cease to hold office.
