Brunei Education Employment Training (BEET) is a leading provider of recruitment services for employers. We can help you build your brand and attract the best talent.

This project developed an innovative solution to the challenge of preventing Covid-19 transmission in shared working environments. A return to offices that house thousands of workers could not have been possible, during the Covid pandemic phase. A key to reducing business costs would have been to cut office space. This impacted capacity as companies tried to meet the regulatory demands to socially distance staff.

Several studies showed a majority of UK workers wanted to continue working remotely after the pandemic, however not leaving home to travel to work in certain individuals has been linked to mental illness in the form of anxiety and stress. Measures to address the health challenge posed by COVID-19 that were used by flexible workspace operators (enhanced manual cleaning, disposable PPE) were not sustainable.

Brunel University London and Space Republic, a UK SME, developed, tested and validated an innovative solution in the form of an office pod system which included strict decontamination processes following operator use. This collaborative innovation focused on the application of existing chemical free technologies that are aimed to destroy pathogens within the pod with a focus on COVID-19. Original funding for this project came from Brunel's RSDO managed Innovation Voucher and Impact Acceleration Award. Later, Space Republic and the Brunel team worked together to secure Innovate UK funding. The project received significant media coverage that helped to promote the products and its impact.
